## MINUTES

4) APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES
a) Approval of Council Meeting Minutes of April 20, 2016 was tabled, as there was not a quorum present.

## MOVED TO AGENDA ITEM \# 5, d) WALK ALONG

Vice Chair Catherina Nou announced that she would be taking this item out of order.

d) Walk Along

They have produced an 80 -minute motion picture called "My Sunset Girl". This movie was made here at Cal Expo and will be having a private showing on at the Benvenuti Performing Art Center.
CEO Pickering informed the Council that a Bernie Sanders 2016 rally was held at Cal Expo on May 9, 2016. There were approximately 15,000 people in attendance.
CEO Pickering reported that Rock and Brews, a franchise food, beverage and family entertainment venue had contacted Cal Expo to explore a ground lease for the former Paradise Island property. This item was taken to the Board of Directors for Cal Expo, who instructed staff to continue to explore this concept.
