



Goal: Imitate technique inspectors use to detect the presence of insects in their area

Supplies: 8 1/2" x 11" cardstock, petroleum jelly (vaseline), cotton balls, & 15 inch string


Steps:


- 1. Fold cardstock into 3 sections and spread petroleum jelly on the middle section with cotton balls.
- 2. Punch two holes: 1 hole on each outer section about 1/2 inch away from the edge.
- 3. Thread the string through the 2 holes, make a knot, and make a second knot at the strings' end, so there is a hanging loop.
- 4. Hang the trap on a tree branch outside. Check on it after a week to see how many insects land in the trap.





Area for Petroleum Jelly
