a) Cal Expo Updates

CEO Pickering started with acknowledging that the universe and Cal Expo have been turned upside down. Cal Expo was requested to facilitate a drive through COVID-19 testing facility that is one of the State largest testing facilities. Cal Expo was also requested to assist the State, City and County to receive 63 trailers from FEMA that are isolation and recovery trailers for homeless that have tested positive for COVID. CEO Pickering continued with a question and answer period discussing Governor's May revise, additional COVID-19 impacts, Council Member suggestions.
