DISPLAY OF DEPARTMENTAL BADGE AND IDENTIFICATION CARD

400.401 PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to specify the requirements for the display of a Departmental badge and identification card.

400.402 POLICY

A. Uniformed Sworn Officers

1. Uniformed sworn officers shall wear the Departmental badge, as specified by the uniform manual, plainly visible on the outermost garment worn.
2. Uniformed sworn officers shall carry a valid Departmental identification card while on-duty.
3. Officers shall show their identification to any person demanding to see it.
 - a. If a person demands to see an officer's identification card at a time when such display would endanger the officer's safety, the officer need not comply.

B. Plainclothes Personnel

1. Sworn officers wearing plain clothes while on- duty, or while carrying a firearm off-duty, shall carry a Departmental badge and valid identification card.
2. When participating in a high-risk incident (i.e. raid), acting in an emergency, or engaged in other activity where official recognition is necessary, an authorized badge will be worn so as to be plainly visible.
3. An officer, either on or off-duty in plain clothes, who wears a firearm which is visible to the public shall also wear an authorized metal badge, which is plainly visible, adjacent to the firearm.
